

## PROVIDER FAQs – MEMBER COVERAGE AFTER INDIVIDUAL & FAMILY PLAN (IFP) TERMINATION DECEMBER 31, 2025

How is continuity or transition of care managed?  Continuity or transition of care allows members to continue receiving care from a provider who is not in the Banner Aetna network if they are in an active course of treatment.  Members and providers should coordinate with the member's new plan to secure the applicable approvals for continued care.  This applies to new members enrolling in a Banner Aetna plan for 2025 or existing members whose provider leaves the network.  Are members enrolled in a Banner Aetna individual & continuity or transition of care if their participating provider leaves the network between now and December 31, 2025.  Will continuity or transition of care be available after December 31, 2025, for members enrolled in a Banner Aetna IFP?  Will continuity or transition of care approvals will end on December 31, 2025, when Banner Aetna exits the individual market. Members and providers should work with the member's new health plan during Open Enrollment to coordinate care. Banner Aetna will not have access to information about members' new coverage.
